Our year is wrapping up quickly and, as you can see from the dates below, there is something happening every day until May 31, when we say our goodbyes for summer. Please pay close attention to events that impact your child's class. It is disappointing for your child to arrive at school after an appointment to find out that the class has gone on a field trip!

A big thank you to all who filled out surveys throughout the school year. The latest survey is from the state and was shared from WASD in mid-April. You are asked to fill out this survey by May 17 in order to give information about how well we keep you involved and informed in your child's education. As always, your feedback lets us know ways that we can improve the learning experiences of our students.

And now a follow-up on the safety surveys. The data from your survey responses, implemented changes, evidence pieces gathered at school, and work from the CDSA leadership team was presented for review. We were awarded with **Level 1** certification in **Safe and Collaborative Culture** through Marzano Research--High Reliability Schools. A heads up for next year is that we will continue our work through Level 2, Effective Teaching in Every Classroom. If you are predicting more surveys, you are right! There are five levels in all, each building on previous levels, with the goal of making your child's school experience safe, engaging, and effective, as well as clear communication about progress that is meaningful to you and your child.

Thank you for the privilege of working with your children this year. My wish is that your summer plans include lots of play and relaxing, with a daily dose of reading and mathematical thinking to keep young brains growing until school resumes on August 26.
