




Note Catcher: Central Idea and Supporting Details

<p>Learning Targets</p> 	<p>You will be able to determine the central idea of a text. You will be able to identify the details that demonstrate the central idea.</p>
<p>What is a central Idea?</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A central idea is a main point that the author is making (also called a main idea or a key idea) • In other words, a central idea is what the article is mostly about. You can think of a central idea as a thesis statement: one sentence that states what the article is about. A text could have more than one central idea.
<p>Central Idea (slides 4-5)</p>	<p>Follow the directions on the slide.</p>
<p>What are supporting details?</p> 	<p>(Do not copy the information that is in purple on this slide)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Supporting details are additional information that will explain, define, or prove an idea. You are proving you are RIGHT! • This means that supporting details prove the central idea in a paragraph or essay.
