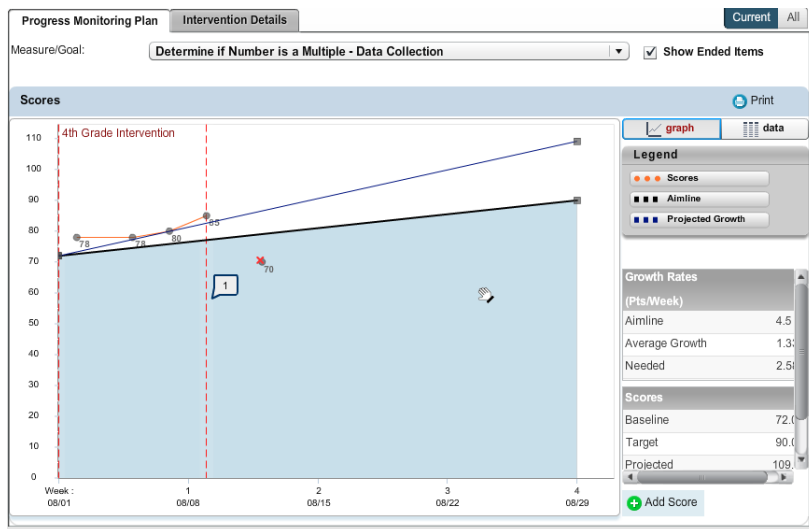


Progress Monitoring Graphs

Description	Action
Once you have a plan for a student, and you have entered scores for the plan goals, you can view the student's progress on a graph.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Click on the student's name • Click on Monitoring from the gray navigation panel
Key Point: There may be more than one measure/goal for the student.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Click the Measure/Goal dropdown • Select the Measure you want to display
The default view is a graph. Each point on the graph represents a student score.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hover over a score point to display student score data <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * The black line is the Aimline * The blue line is the Projected Growth
<p>Key Point: Scores can be entered directly from the Monitoring page by clicking the Add Score button.</p>	
You can mark a score to be ignored if you feel it is an anomaly, but you have to provide a reason. Ignored scores are not used by EXCEED in calculating progress.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Click a score point • Click the Ignore this Score checkbox • Enter a reason in the textbox • Click OK

<p>A note marker (red dashed line) can be added to the graph using the Notes link in the gray navigation panel. Make sure to click the More Option check box and select Show on Graphs.</p> <p>Key Point: See the <i>Entering a Note Quick Start Guide</i> for the details on entering notes.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • See the Entering a Note Quick Start Guide
<p>By default EXCEED display data for current intervention plan scores. You can see all monitoring data using the Show Ended Item checkbox, and All button.</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Click the Show Ended Item checkbox to show data for ended plans • Click the All button to display measures for all plans
<p>You can print the graph to use in RTI meeting, in parent meeting, or as a general reference.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Click the Print icon located above the graph button
<p>The data can also be viewed as raw data by clicking the Data button. This view displays the score information in in a table format.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Click the Data tab
<p>The Intervention Details tab (beside progress monitoring tab) displays information the Intervention name and a log of intervention details.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Click the Intervention Details tab
