Safety Update

West Ada School District has a new check in system for parents and visitors. The Raptor Security System is a visitor management system that is used to protect the students, faculty and other visitors at the schools. It reads the visitor's driver's license and compares that information to a sex offender database. It will alert school administrators if a match is found. Please remember to bring your driver's license or state issued ID every time you come to check in to the building.
