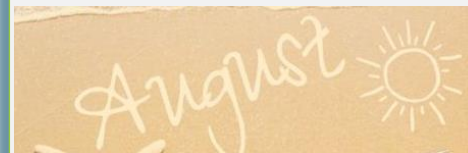

We will also have lists posted the first day of school and teachers will be greeting students at the door. This year students will have the opportunity to meet the teacher and bring schools supplies (meet and greet) into class before school August 25th 3:00 P.M - 6:00 P.M. For the first day we will start at 9:05 and will be early release at 1:25 (Kinder schedule page 1) You can find your students bus number and schedule by going to www.westada.org and clicking on the bus stop tab at the top. For parents that are dropping off or picking up please use the East parking lot. Thanks in advance for your patience and safety for our students.

- ★ WestAda district requires you to register your student each school year. This will allow you to update emergency information & see their current grades. Please log onto your PowerSchool account in order to do this. Our office staff is happy to help reset those forgotten passwords.
- ★ For your children's safety, we also ask families to please bring their ID when checking out their student. Thank you for understanding!



Parking and Student Drop Off

Safety of our students is top priority. Please be patient and follow our pickup/drop off procedures.

1. Enter the parking lot on the east side of campus. This is the parking lot closest to the church.
2. Please pull all the way forward.
3. Please do not leave your car unattended in the pickup/drop off lane. This will hold up traffic and makes the process move slower.
4. Please help your child be prepared to exit the vehicle. IF they are seated on the side closest to the school their exit from the car will be safer.
5. You may park and walk your student onto campus.
6. Please do not drop your child off in the faculty parking lot on the west side of campus. THERE IS NO ADULT SUPERVISION IN THAT LOT AND IT IS NOT SAFE FOR STUDENT FOOT TRAFFIC.
7. Please DO NOT enter the bus lane (in front of the school). We need to keep this open for bus traffic.

2. Click on PowerSchool icon

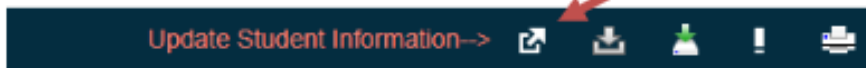


3. Login to account (call school office to reset if you don't remember)
