COLLEGE TRANSCRIPTS

Need College Transcripts for Dual-Credit courses?

College Transcripts are separate and different from EHS High School Transcripts.

EHS does not have access to student college transcripts!

When applying to college, they may request transcripts for college credits you have received in high school.

Many colleges allow unofficial college transcripts for admissions.

Once students are accepted into a college, they will require an OFFICIAL college transcript after graduation.

College transcripts have a fee that is paid to the college before they will be sent

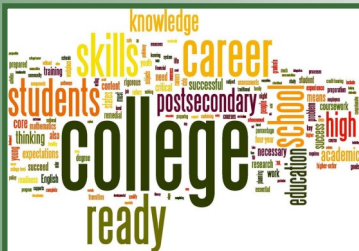

JUNIORS SAT College Entrance Exam

Juniors: The SAT will be administered at no cost to all juniors (class of 2019) at EHS on **Tuesday, April 9, 2019.**

Since completing a college entrance exam (SAT or ACT) is a graduation requirement, we are planning on all junior students taking advantage of the opportunity to take the SAT for free on Tuesday, April 9th. All junior students will be automatically registered by West Ada staff for the exam.

On Test Day Bring:

- Photo ID (driver's license, passport, or school ID)
- Acceptable calculator (with new batteries)
List of acceptable calculators is available at collegeboard.org
- No. 2 pencils (not mechanical) with soft erasers
- Snacks or water for breaks (optional)
