



Mountain View High School has an ingrained culture of placing a high value on instructional opportunities for our students. In support of this philosophy, the school is faced with the challenge of limiting student tardiness to class. Starting in the 2017-2018 school year, a cycle of progressive discipline and interventions will be implemented to act as both a deterrent and to provide supplemental time for missed academic opportunities.

The system will look as follows:

- 1) Students receive 3 Warnings per semester
- 2) Students will need to serve 30 minutes for each Tardy or 60 minutes for Tardy Late over 3 (Wednesday-Thursday 3:00-5:00 and Monday Friday during lunch)
- 3) Failure to serve a tardy detention within two weeks of assignment will result in a Saturday School
- 4) Failure to serve a Saturday School will result in a Friday School

Friday and Saturday schools will be administered on the Mountain View campus by certificated math and English teachers. The two-hour block (Friday 3:00-5:00 and Saturday (8:00-10:00) will allow students to catch up on their classes and receive assistance as needed in both math and English.
