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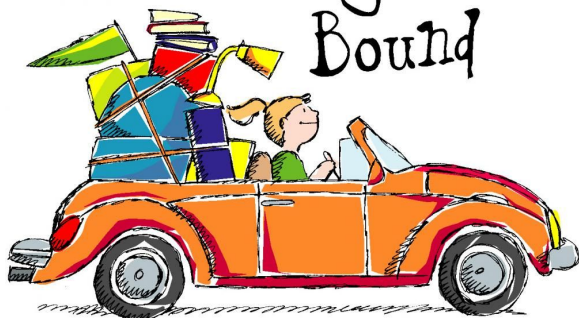

Medication Policy

Students who need to take prescribed or other medication during your time here at Rebound must bring it to the front office or nurse in a properly labeled prescription bottle or original container.

No medication will be accepted in envelopes, bags, etc.

A consent form must be completed by the parent for any student under the age of 18 and will be kept on file at the school.

Meridian Schools Clinic

The Meridian Schools Clinic (MSC) is a collaborative venture between the Family Medicine Residency of Idaho (FMRI) and the West Ada School District. The clinic delivers high quality health care to children and adolescents. The clinic is staffed by a multidisciplinary team of health professionals including a Nurse Practitioner, social worker, and dietician. The clinic staff works cooperatively with school nurses, coaches, counselors, classroom teachers, and school principals and their staff to assure that the school-based health center is an integral part of the life of the schools served. Our shared goal is to help children succeed in school and in life by keeping them healthy, in school, and ready to learn. Flu vaccination can reduce flu illnesses, doctors' visits, missed school/work due to flu, as well as prevent flu-related hospitalizations.

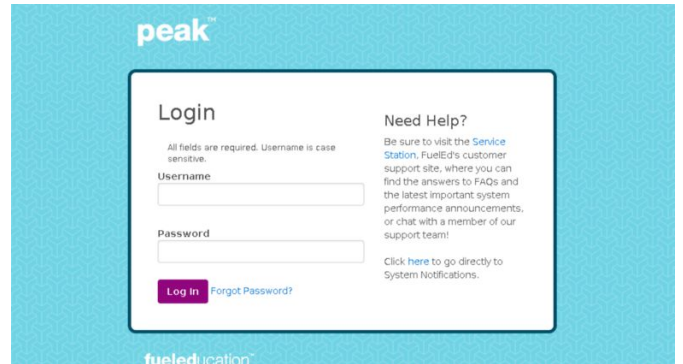


Students should stay home from school if they have a fever greater than 100 degrees F that is accompanied by sore throat, headache, nausea, rash, muscle aches or listlessness.



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
