INFORMATION YOU NEED TO GET YOUR PIN

- Your Social Security number
- Your full and correct last name
- Your full and correct first name
- Your middle initial
- Your date of birth
- Your street address
- Your e-mail address (optional)

DOCUMENTS NEEDED TO APPLY:

- Your Social Security number
- Your parent's Social Security numbers, if you are providing parent information.
- Your driver's license number, if you have one
- Your Alien Registration Number, if you are not a U. S. citizen.
- Federal tax information or tax returns including IRS W-2 information, for yourself and spouse, if you are married, and for your parents if you are providing parent information.
 - ▶ If you have not yet filed an income tax return, complete and submit the FAFSA using estimated tax information
 - ▶ Use income records for the year prior to the academic year for which you are applying: for instance, if you are filling out the 2016 FAFSA you will need 2015 tax information
- Records of your untaxed income, such as Social Security benefits, Temporary Assistance for Needy Families benefits and veterans benefits, for yourself, and for your parents if you are providing parent information.
- Information on savings, investments, and business and farm assets for yourself, and for your parents if you are providing parent information.
