





**FAST FORWARD PROGRAM (Funded by Idaho State Legislature)  
AP Exam Student Instructions**



The Fast Forward Program provides a total of **\$4125** to be used throughout grades 7 - 12. Funds can be applied to any of the following: Concurrent Credits, AP exams, IB exams or qualifying PTE exams. In order to access Fast Forward funds for concurrent credit classes, students must follow the instructions and meet the deadlines below. Fast Forward Instructions for Concurrent Credit classes, AP exams, and CTE exams are available on a different sheet.

<p>Must be completed on or before <b>February 7<sup>th</sup></b>.</p> <p><b><u>If you have previously created an account to use Fast Forward funds and it was approved, proceed to step 2, part a.</u></b></p> 	<p><b>Step 1.</b> Fast Forward Registration occurs through the Idaho State Department's website. <b>If you have previously created an account to use your Fast Forward funds please move on to step 2, part a.</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Go to <a href="http://advancedops.sde.idaho.gov">http://advancedops.sde.idaho.gov</a> (use Chrome as your browser)</li> <li>Click <b>register account</b> on the top right of your screen</li> <li>Enter the following information:             <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Edu ID number (State ID # this can be found in PowerSchool)</li> <li>Your personal email address</li> <li>Create a password (that you will remember)</li> <li>Your Full legal first and last name and your middle initial (as it appears in PowerSchool)</li> <li>Your birthdate and gender (if your birthday is June 5, 1998 enter it as <b>6/5/1998</b> not 06/05/1998)</li> <li>Select Joint School District No. 2 as your school district</li> <li>Select your high school</li> </ol> </li> <li>Check the "I have read..." box and click <b>enroll new student</b> <b>Check your email and follow the steps to verify the account!</b></li> </ol>
<p>Must be completed on or before <b>February 14<sup>th</sup></b>.</p> <p><b><u>Once student applies for Fast Forward funds they MUST complete the school's exam registration. Please complete step 3.</u></b></p> 	<p><b>Step 2.</b> You will receive an email notifying you if your account has been approved or denied. If your account is denied use steps a and b below and click on view profile to edit any mistakes (check your name and birth date remember these items should match PowerSchool). If your account has been approved decide which course(s) you want to use your FF funds for. Then complete the following steps:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Go to <a href="http://advancedops.sde.idaho.gov">http://advancedops.sde.idaho.gov</a> (use Chrome as your browser) and Click <b>Login</b> on the top right of your screen</li> <li>Login using the same email and password you created</li> <li>From the left side of the screen select <b>Request Funding</b></li> <li>Select <b>Exam</b></li> <li>From the drop down menus select the following:             <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>2019-2020</li> <li>Joint School District No. 2</li> <li>Your high school</li> <li>Your grade level</li> <li>Spring</li> <li>Advanced Placement</li> <li>Choose the exam your instructor indicates</li> <li>Exam Date Given by your instructor</li> <li>Click submit exam</li> </ol> </li> <li><b>You will need to complete this step again for <u>EACH</u> AP exam you want pay for with Fast Forward funds.</b></li> </ol> <div data-bbox="1228 958 2016 1104" style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px; margin-top: 10px;"> <p align="center"><b><u>As per state statute and district policy 603.22, your Fast Forward funds will be frozen next year if you earn less than a 2 or failed to sit for an AP exam you paid for using Fast Forward funds.</u></b></p> </div>
