

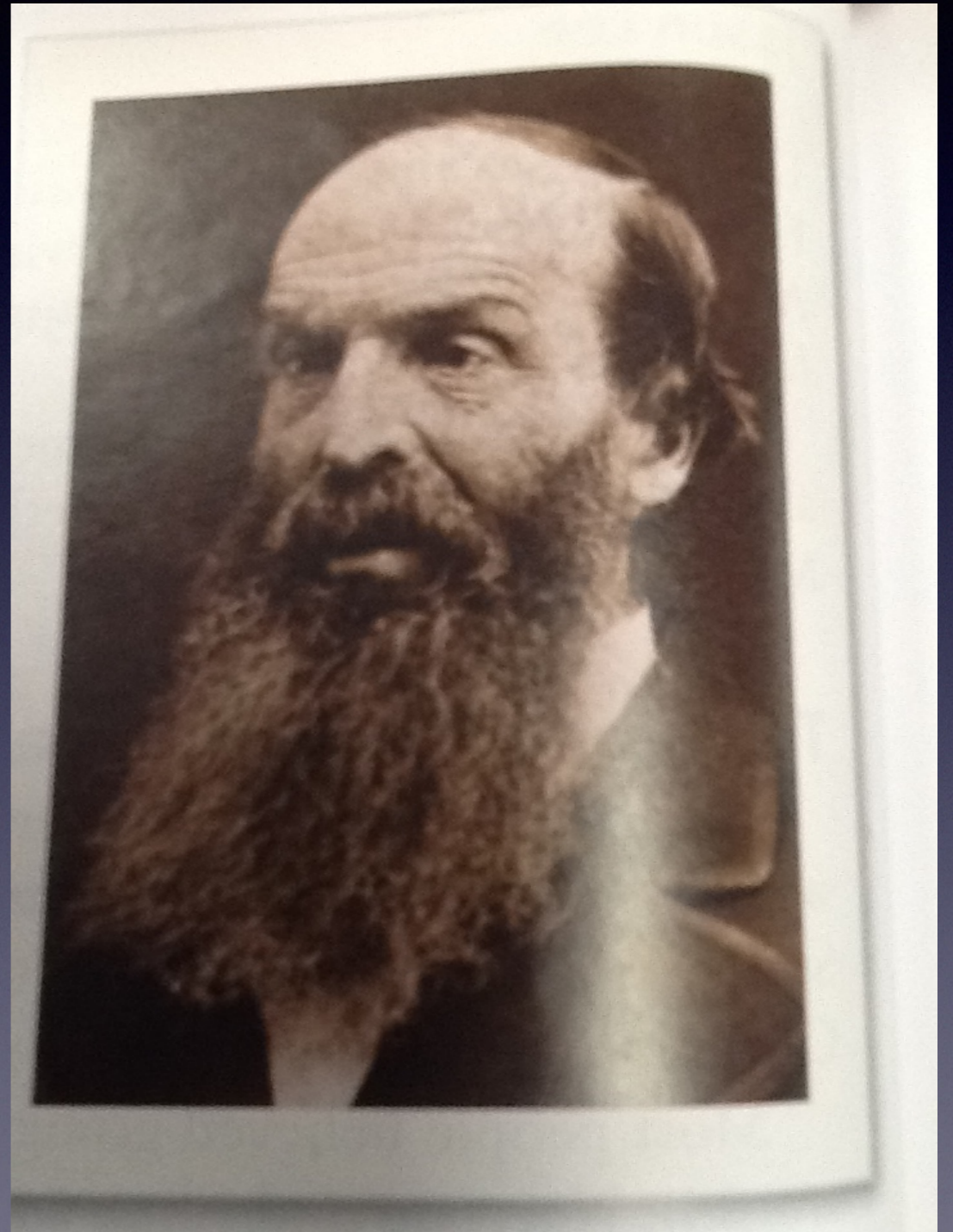
# The Lapwai mission
