

Unit 2 Narrative Final

Your Task - You have spent Unit 2 reading, discussing, and writing in response to texts in the Narrative genre.

REQUIREMENTS

This is a formal assignment and should reflect the effort and neatness that is expected of a final project!

Formal writing includes:

1. Proofreading – This is the only way you avoid silly errors and sound professional
2. Typing – There are no excuses here; you will have almost 2 hours of class time to type
3. Neat Assembly – Your narratives should reflect effort on your part
4. **MUST be turned in NO LATER THAN October 23 for A Day and October 24 for B Day**

Narrative Final Drafts

1. Final drafts of narratives must be typed and in MLA Format
2. The whole narrative should include one title
3. Different narrative types can be together in one document or printed separately and stapled

Narrative Rough Drafts for Each Narrative Type

1. The original narrative(s) you wrote during class or created before finalizing
2. Should have edits and/or notes from peer and self-editing

MLA headings include your name, teachers name, the class, and the date. Your margins should be 1 inch and your paper should be double spaced. The title should be centered but not bold or underlined.
