



## District Art Show 2018-2019

West Ada Parents/Guardians,

The District's annual art project is now underway for the *District Art Show*. Each student is encouraged to submit one piece of art to his/her home school. Each school will then choose one piece of art from those submitted as the *School's Choice Award* winner. Those pieces will be prominently displayed at the District Service Center for one (1) year and will be returned to the student in May the following year. There will be one *District Choice Award* winner chosen from each level: elementary, middle, and high school.

Additional pieces will be selected to receive awards which include:

- \* Meridian Mayor's Award
- \* Star Mayor's Award
- \* Eagle Mayor's Award
- \* Superintendent's Award
- \* Boise State University Dean of Education Award
- \* Eagle Chamber of Commerce Award
- \* Board of Trustees' Award (Elementary, Middle, and High School)
- \* West Ada Directors' Award
- \* Idaho State University's Award
- \* Eagle Arts Commission Award
- \* Meridian Arts Commission Awards

The pieces chosen for these awards will hang in the respective offices for one (1) year. They will be returned to the artists in May of the following year.

*School Choice Award* winners will be honored at an art show and reception on **April 25** for Elementary and Secondary at the Renaissance High School Auditorium. Students and their families along with their teachers and principals will be invited.

### Timeline:

October – March	Creation of artwork
March or sooner	Selection of building <i>School Choice Award</i> winner
<b>March 15</b>	Selections delivered to District Office
March 15-April 19	Selections are matted and framed
April 5	Invitations mailed to <i>School Choice Award</i> winners and winners' families, teachers, principals, and dignitaries.
<b>April 25</b>	Elementary and Secondary Art Show and Reception

### Criteria

- ◆ *Size:* 2 dimensional work (painting, collage, prints, drawings, photography, etc.) **no larger than 18" x 24"**, must be flat and not exceed more than a 3/8-inch thickness. Entries may be submitted on paper, canvas board, or cardboard. **Please DO NOT frame.** There is no size limitation on 3-dimensional work.
- ◆ *Subject/Theme:* **Celebrate Idaho in Our Community.** Artwork should be appropriate for display in public offices.
- ◆ *School or Home:* Work submitted may be done at school or at home with the understanding that it is clearly the student's original work.
- ◆ *Submission:* Each student's submission must be accompanied by a completed student entry form.
