## I. April Meeting Minutes – Approved as written.

## II. Treasurer's Report

- President Eric Wahlers reported on behalf of Treasurer Brandy Wahlers a balance of 7173.13.

## III. Old Business

- Wooden Roses: Matt obtained approval from Albertsons at Ustick & Five Mile for us to sell the roses for Mother's Day. This will take place Saturday, May 13<sup>th</sup>, from 2:00 to 4:00. The table will be manned by students, not parents.
- Band Aid Banquet – Ms. Brings has reserved the social center, and she is also arranging for an auctioneer and judges for the dessert auction.
- 501(c)(3) status: This is in process, probably completed within the next week or so.

## IV. Nomination of Next Year's Officers

- President: Elisabeth Billman accepted the nomination and was elected as President.
- Vice President: Matt Greenway accepted the nomination and was elected Vice President.
- Treasurer: Ms. Brings has approached three potential nominees who will let her know if they decide to accept. At that point, the boosters will conduct an online election.
- Secretary: Mary Abajian accepted the nomination and was elected Secretary
- Webmaster: Shelly Hiner had previously accepted the nomination, and was elected as Webmaster.

## V. New Business

- The membership voted to provide \$250 for each of the three drum majors to offset costs of drum major camp.

## VI. Ms. Brings' Announcements

- The band will provide a boutonniere and corsage for each senior member of the band at the Year End Concert.
- The Band calendar is up to date through next fall, other than events that are pending finalization of the football schedule.
- Fees: There are several options for obtaining necessary funds for the upcoming year.
  - Don't grade marching band, and charge the regular fee.
  - Make Marching Band an extracurricular activity and charge the regular fee. This would prohibit Ms. Brings from grading it as a class or requiring attendance.
  - Charge a small fee and rely on donations that are tax deductible. Ms. Brings is leaning toward this option.
- For the End of Year Concert, Students must be at the school at 6:00 for rehearsal with the other bands participating. This is the only rehearsal they will have together.

- Tuxes must be retained for the graduation performance, except for seniors.
