

CENTENNIAL BAND BOOSTERS MEETING MINUTES

March 6, 2018

Meeting called to order by President Elisabeth Billman at 7:19 p.m.

I. Minutes from last meeting approved.

II. Treasurer's Report

- Elisabeth presented the report on behalf of Treasurer Julie Pipal, who was unable to attend.
- Our balance is \$3,965.59, but only \$2,465.59 of that will be available after we pay for the new storage shed.
- Treasurer's Report approved.

III. Old Business

- Eric Wahler reported that 501(c)(3) status with IRS is still pending. He noted that if a new slate of officers take office before we are approved, the entire application process must be repeated. The membership agreed we will take this into account as we elect officers for the 2018-2019 school year.

IV. New Business

- Chipotle Night Fundraiser Update
 - Elisabeth completed an online application to reserve April 10th, at the Village location.
 - We will receive a percentage of every sale where the customer submits our flyer between 4:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m.
- March 22nd Gala Update
 - Shelly has produced professional quality posters for the school and businesses.
 - She urged members to sign up to donate for the silent auction, even small items can be grouped together for a single basket.
 - Elisabeth will re-send the e-mail with the SignUp Genius link.
- Band Aid
 - Once our caterer has confirmed his availability, we can choose among the following possible dates: May 10th, May 11th, May 15th, and May 18th.
- Yard Sale Update
 - Set for April 28th
 - Lowell Scott has authorized us to use their parking lot. The membership discussed the reasons for using Lowell Scott versus Centennial's parking lot, and decided the additional traffic from Eagle Road made Lowell Scott the better choice.

- New Officers for 2018-2019 School Year:
 - Elisabeth will check with Matt and Julie to see if they are interested in serving in their respective board positions again next year. Mary said she would run for secretary again if needed. Nicole and Erica expressed interest in the serving as president with Erica open to vice-president as well.
 - Actual nominations will take place at a subsequent meeting, and the change of officers will be timed to work with the 501(c)(3) completion.
 - Elisabeth will remind parents that board positions are available for those interested in serving.

V. Ms. Brings' Announcements

- The next two weeks will be very busy for her, so she may be unable to return calls and e-mails as promptly as usual. All events are on the Band Calendar.
- Band Concert and Freshman Open House, March 13th.
- District and Large Group Band Festival, March 16th.
 - Students who volunteer to help must attend training.
 - Students who participate will be released from class.
- Marching Band schedule for 2018-2019 is pending, but District III Festival is already scheduled for October 27th.
- Centennial is slated to receive \$30,000 next year for new instruments. Ms. Brings has allocated the funds where most needed.
- The Band Trip happens next year, for Sophomores, Juniors and Seniors.
 - Cost will be less than \$400.
 - The destination has not been decided.
- We own 104 uniforms, and there are 82 Symphonic Band members this year. As such, marching band may grow to the point that we need to plan for purchasing more uniforms in the next few years.
