

CENTENNIAL BAND BOOSTERS MEETING MINUTES

September 10, 2018

Meeting called to order by President Nicole Ruby at 7:05 p.m.

I. Minutes from August 2018 meeting approved.

II. Treasurer's Report – Treasurer Julie Eavenson

- Julie was unable to attend. President Ruby reported that the bank balance is approximately \$5,200 after deducting money set aside for the storage shed, as well as expenses approved at the August 2018 meeting.
- The board is working on a budget for this school year, which will likely be presented at the October Booster Meeting.
 - Goal is to plan for likely expenses in advance, then set fundraising goals.
 - In-kind donations will be tracked and included.

VI. Ms. Brings’ Announcements

A. Football coach Dave Koch has requested that the band help pay for a portion of the cost of painting the field before each home game.

- Ms. Brings asked that the Boosters contribute \$450, which represents the cost of painting the field one and a half times. She noted that the band uses the field for practice two to three times per week, and that the football team donated its old press box tower to the marching band.
- Motion made and approved to spend the requested \$450.

B. Caldwell Competition September 29th.

- Students will report to Centennial at noon, and will likely not return until 8:00. Centennial performs at 5:05 p.m.
- Permission forms going out this week
- Food will be arranged.

C. Pocatello Competition October 13th

- No itinerary available yet, but will leave at approximately 6:30 a.m. that morning, returning the same day.
- Transportation will be by charter buses.

- Cost will likely be about \$58 per student.
- The band needs 10 to 13 parents for pit crew.

- Centennial is classed as 5A Large School this year.
- We will likely march around 7:00 p.m.
- Tickets are \$11.00 for adults, \$9.00 for students, and are available in advance from the Boosters.
- Ms. Brings has forms for parents to purchase “Good Luck Wishes” for their student to be published in the DIII program. Cost is \$5.00 per line, and Centennial receives half that amount back as a fundraiser.
