

CENTENNIAL BAND BOOSTERS MEETING MINUTES

Meeting called to order by President Nicole Ruby at 7:10 p.m.

I. Band Director's Announcements, Brittany Brings

- The Caldwell Band Competition went very well.
- Pocatello Competition is at Idaho State University, October 13th.
 - Permission slip must be returned with \$58 to cover food/transportation.
 - Itinerary has been sent by e-mail; if any parent did not receive it, they need to let Ms. Brings know their correct address.
 - The Band needs parents to help with Pit Crew, whether they ride the bus or drive separately. Please use SignUp Genius, or let Ms. Brings know if you can help.
- District III Competition is Saturday, October 27th at BSU.
 - Final rehearsal is Friday, October 26th, at 5:00, then students perform in the stadium for parents at 8:00. There is no cost to attend, and friends and family are welcome.
 - Saturday call time is 2:30 – students meet at Centennial and ride a bus to BSU.
 - We perform at 6:15
 - Awards Ceremony is at 8:45, and students should return to the school by around 10:00. They will then watch a video of their performance and have pizza.
- October 30th is the Fall Band Concert; dress us concert black or marching uniform.
- November 6th is the Fall Marching Band Banquet; details to follow.
- November 8th is the Centennial Booster Gala. Jazz Band will perform.

 - Julie presented a draft budget for discussion.

- She noted that line items will change as the year progresses, and that expenditures are always subject to discussion and member approval.
- After discussion, the membership voted to table the approval of the budget until the next meeting. Julie will make changes to the format, and update as appropriate before then.

- Those helping with Pocatello, DIII, and/or Fall Banquet will meet on October 11th in the small ensemble room at 6:45 to create snack bags and decorations.
