Meeting Called to Order by Vice President Erica Ziebarth at 7:00 p.m. President Nicole Ruby was out of town.

I. Minutes of February and March Boosters meetings approved.

II. Treasurer's Report approved. Treasurer Julie Eavenson.

- Julie reported a balance of \$4757.72 on March 1st, and a current balance of \$8196.51, with \$1500 reserved for the shed.
- Expenses paid were \$256.89 for pizza for middle school visitors, and \$662.74 for embroidery and materials for the Vintage Centennial project.
- Tomorrow's Jazz Tonight event net revenue was \$3124.00, with \$1433 of that amount in ticket sales and \$1781 from the silent auction.

III. Events/Volunteers/Committees:

- Shelly reported that the Tomorrow's Jazz Tonight Event was a success, with an increase in revenues from both ticket sales and the auction. We sold 107 tickets.

 - This event includes a dinner provided at cost, with a live auction for desserts made by students.

 - We need volunteers to load and drive the box truck to Savers with donations.
- Vintage Centennial is currently \$300 in the black after expenses. Erica encouraged members to promote the products on their social network.
