I. Meeting Called to Order by President Nicole Ruby at 7:00 p.m. and Minutes Approved.

II. Treasurer's Report – Julie Eavenson

- Julie presented the attached report detailing income and expenses between December 31, 2018 and February 5, 2019.
- She distributed copies of the attached 2018-2019 budget which was approved on January 8th, 2019.

III. Events, Volunteers and Committees

- Tomorrow's Jazz Tonight event set for Thursday, March 21st at the Sapphire Room. Shelly Hiner, Chair.
 - Tickets will range from \$15 to \$20.
 - If we fill the venue, The Sapphire Room will likely schedule us on a weekend night in future years.
 - There is a link to purchase tickets or donate for the silent auction on the Centennial Band Website.
- Band Aid – Erica Ziebarth, Chair
 - Set for May 9th, in the Centennial Social Center.
 - Band Aid is an informal fundraiser with a Dessert Auction and catered meal.
 - Erica will ask for volunteers beginning in early April.

IV. Fundraising – Shelly Hiner, Fundraising Chair

- Yard Sale and Savers Fundraiser set for April 27th.
 - Savers pays by the pound for clothing and shoes. Families that participate in the Garage Sale may donate their unsold items to the Savers fundraiser.
 - Funds raised go toward next year's expenses.
- Vintage Centennial Fundraiser to pay for new uniforms - Erica Ziebarth
 - "Vintage Centennial" items will be made from deconstructed marching band uniforms that are no longer in use.

- Nicole confirmed for the membership that costs to produce the items had previously been approved and included in the budget.
- Presales start tonight, and close February 21st.
- Sales open to the public on March 1st.
- Erica needs volunteers to prepare the uniforms for the seamstress.
- Dinner Out Fundraisers – Shelly is working with several local restaurants, but waiting for confirmation on specific dates.

V. Old Business

- Eric Wahlers, former Centennial Band Boosters President, updated the membership on building the storage shed, which has already been funded with a \$1500 donation.
 - Because the Boosters are now a 501(c)(3) entity, vendors who donate materials will receive a tax write off.
 - Any funds remaining from the \$1500 will revert to the Band Boosters.
 - Eric will provide receipts for materials, and his company will donate all labor, although he welcomes any parents/students who are able to help.
 - Ms. Brings will check on whether we can build during the school week.
 - Weather may prevent starting on the original date of March 1st, but Eric is optimistic about starting in early April.
 - The membership voted to include a thank you and credit to Eric's company in the programs for the spring concerts.
