**Meeting Called to Order by President Nicole Ruby at 7:08 p.m.**

***I. Minutes of April Boosters meeting approved.***

***II. Treasurer's Report approved. Treasurer Julie Eavenson provided the attached Budget.***

- Julie reported a beginning balance as of our last meeting of \$8196.51, with \$1500 reserved for the shed. Ending Balance is \$7852.00.
- Expenses paid were \$1051.11 for Vintage Centennial operating expenses, bus parking in Seattle, parking for caterer in Seattle, Idaho Sales Tax, and scholarships for three students to go to Seattle.
- Revenue was \$706.60 from Vintage Centennial and Band Aid pre-sale.
- Our fiscal year will end June 31<sup>st</sup>.
- Aleta Luke, a band parent with accounting expertise, has volunteered to review our financials.

***III. Events/Volunteers/Committees:***

- Band Aid – Erica Ziebarth, Chair
  - Casual dinner and auction, Set for May 9<sup>th</sup>, in the Centennial Social Center.
  - Erica has received 131 RSVPs.
  - An adequate number of people have volunteered for set-up and take down.

***IV. Fundraising:***

- The Yard Sale yielded an average of about \$100 per student who participated.
- Savers soft-goods collection earned \$418 for the band program.
- Buffalo Wild Wings Dine-Out netted \$69, which is a good result.
- Vintage Centennial revenue to date is \$2450, with a net profit of \$130. However, we have over \$7,000 in product that is ready to ship and has already been paid for.
  - Erica is focused on Centennial reunions to market to alumni.

- Ms. Brings expressed her gratitude to the Booster club for their help throughout the year.
- The Seattle trip went smoothly and was a great success.
- Ms. Brings is excited to welcome a new staff person for next year, Sebastian Svet, a junior at BSU, who plays with the Blue Devils.
- The State Solo competition in Pocatello last weekend went very well.
  - Centennial had more entrants than all but one other school.
  - Centennial won more medals than any other school.
  - Ms. Brings encourages all students to consider participating in solo or ensemble competition.
- The students met the minimum number of raffle sales to try for the \$1,000 goal.
- The year-end concert is next Thursday, May 16<sup>th</sup>. It will include a special opportunity for each senior to tell about their experiences in band, and will last about two hours.
- Ms. Brings will soon provide a specific itinerary for the band's participation in graduation on June 1<sup>st</sup>. She reminded the membership that students must arrange their own transportation to Taco Bell Arena.
