Meeting Called to Order by President Erica Pelley Ziebarth at 7:01pm

### **Old Business**

Erica Ziebarth, Band Booster President for the 2019/2020 school year, welcomed parents.

- Minutes Approval of Sept motioned at 7:02pm and approved

### **Treasurer's Report**

Dawn Knecht provided a Treasurer's report of expenses paid and the current balance.

- We have \$1492 in savings for the trailer account.
- The overall balance is \$5250 in the checking account and ads were paid today.
- CHS made \$507 from the good luck ads.

### **New Business/Upcoming Events**

- CHS Utah Trip: Students will leave right after school this Friday and need to pack light. Snack bags will be packed tomorrow evening by the band boosters. Students are given the bags just before they leave. Dinner will be served at a rest stop near Twin Falls and will be pizza. Cami is managing the food. They will stay at the hotel Friday night. Breakfast is served at the hotel, and lunch and snacks will be provided in the parking lot. Students will arrive home around 2:30am. Buses need to be unpacked and equipment put away.
- Senior Night: October 18 is the last football game. Seniors will be celebrated with candy leis and posters.
- Night on the Hill: Special night for students to perform one final time for parents. Parents cheer them on in preparation for DIII the following day. Rehearsal starts at 5:30pm and parents are encouraged to arrive at 8:00pm to fill the stands in support of the band. After the performance kids will meet in the band room to go over all of the details for the next day.
- DIII: Tickets will be sold at practices and at Night on the Hill. Parents are encouraged to pre-purchase tickets to avoid the lines onsite as well as save a few dollars. Students will report to the band room in the early afternoon and will ride together to the competition. They will return to the band room and have pizza and watch their performance. Parents should expect to pick up their student late that night.
- Fall Banquet: The date for the Fall banquet is still under review. Currently looking at November 5<sup>th</sup> and November 12<sup>th</sup>. More detail will be provided as soon as this date is confirmed. If you have a freshman or sophomore who is marching for the first year, they will letter at this event. Dress attire is encouraged. We are working to keep costs very low this year in order to keep funds allocated to the trailer as much as possible.

### **Fundraiser Report**

Shelly Hiner offered an overview of fundraising activities for the year.

- Poinsettia Sales: Packets were picked up by students last week and are due back November 11. Students were divided into team to compete for which team sells the most. Poinsettias are grown locally out of Garden Valley.
- Dine out Night: December 17<sup>th</sup> is Panda Express on Eagle and Fairview from 10am – 10pm. Take your flyer and show it at the cashier to have your meal count toward the CHS Band fundraiser. Blaze Pizza will be on February 11<sup>th</sup> from 6-8pm. Additional details will be provided closer to these dates.
- Jazz Night: The jazz night fundraiser is our largest fundraiser of the year. We keep 100% of ticket sales. Event is held at the Sapphire room at the Riverside Hotel and there will be a silent auction. Parents are encouraged to add items for the silent auction. This can be something you make or items you can purchase and contribute to baskets.
- Savers/Yard Sale: Students run a yard sale table in the Dunkley Music parking lot and then, at the conclusion, we take all soft goods to Savers where we get paid by the pound. Parents are encouraged to save their soft goods all year long, bring them in large lawn bags, and the boosters will haul everything to Savers and collect the per pound fee for the band. Sales from the yard sale tables can be held by the students to be used for future events.

#### **Mrs. Brings Announcements**

- Utah trip details: Students will be staying in rooms in sets of four. They will sign up for their own rooms, but reviewed by Mrs. Brings. Students are well informed of the behavior expectations for this trip. Students aren't allowed to leave their rooms at night after room checks. Students will report for breakfast Saturday morning, then drive to Herriman High School from the hotel. Students will stay in uniform until after the award ceremony for their division. Students should bring jackets and gear for cold weather. They will stay for the majority of the 6A bands. We are using a new bus company, White Castle. The hotel we're staying in is the Hampton Inn.
- Next week, we have a Friday night game on October 18<sup>th</sup>. The following week will have regular practices. Friday October 25<sup>th</sup> is Night on the Hill. Saturday October 26<sup>th</sup> is DIII with our performance at 6:45pm. We are 4<sup>th</sup> from the end. Blue Thunder performs at 7:52 and awards are given at 8:30pm. Students will come back to the school for pizza at the end of the evening.
- October 29 at 7pm is our Fall concert. Marching band will perform inside the CPAC as part of this concert. This concert marks the end of the marching band season.
- Pep band sign ups start tomorrow. This is a volunteer opportunity and a commitment to play at 5 boys' basketball games and 5 girls' basketball games. December 12 will be the winter band concert.
- DIII Music Educators Training will be January 11, 2019. All DIII music educators will be coming to CHS for training. The boosters will be providing breakfast that morning as hosts of this event.
