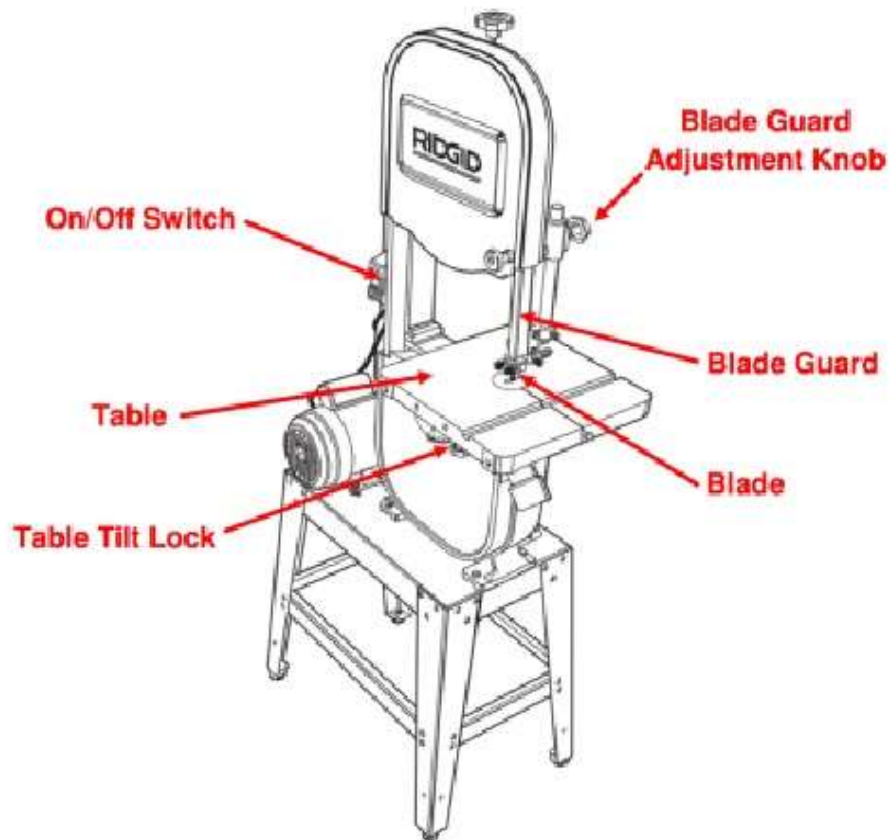

## Drill Press





## Drill Press Safety

1. Be careful not to drill into the vises or drill press table.
2. Use vises clamped to the drill press table if there is the chance that your work piece might spin when drilling.
3. Keep your fingers at least 3" from the drill bit
4. Be sure to clean up the drill press table top, base, and surrounding floor immediately when finished with the machine

## Band Saw Safety

1. Blade Guard/Guide should be 1/4" above the material you are cutting.
2. If the blade breaks back out of the way immediately.  
Shut off the power immediately and notify the teacher.
3. The teeth of the band saw blade should be pointed down
4. Wait for the machine to achieve running speed before starting a cut.
5. Never start the machine with material touching the blade.
6. Always wait for the machine to come to a complete stop before leaving the machine.  
It takes 10 seconds for most band saw to come to a complete stop.
7. Use a piece of wood or a brush to remove debris from around the blade.
8. Do Not back out of a cut while the saw is running.
9. The material you are cutting should be firmly against the band saw table. Not above it.
10. Use relief cuts when cutting distances longer than 3 inches.  
Use relief cuts when cutting curves.
- 11 Feed material smoothly through the band saw, NEVER force it, NEVER rush it.
12. Plan your cuts before you do them.
