Sealed bids will be received at the District Service Center, 1303 East Central Drive Meridian, Idaho 83642 until 2:00 p.m. local time, Monday, November 18, 2019 for the **Mary McPherson Elementary Gravity Irrigation Project**.

The work will consist of removal of the existing underground gravity irrigation piping and relocation, installation of a new irrigation system complete with new piping, irrigation boxes, and fencing. Demolition and removal of existing full growth trees and the concrete piping is part of the project.

A **pre-bid conference** will be held at the project site, 1050 E. Amity Road, Meridian, ID 83646, on Friday, November 08, 2019 at 10:00 a.m. Attendance is recommended.

Bids will be opened at the above stated place and read aloud, following the closing time for receipt of bids. Bidders and other properly interested parties are invited to be present at bid opening.

Beginning Monday, November 04, 2019, bidders may obtain one (1) complete set of plans and specifications at LKV Architects located at 2400 East Riverwalk Drive, Boise ID 83706 for a refundable deposit of \$100.00 per set. Additional sets of documents may be purchased for \$200.00 (non-refundable). Plans will be available at no charge via the online plan rooms noted above.

No Bid may be withdrawn after the scheduled time for receipt of bids unless the award of contract is delayed for a period exceeding sixty (60) days. The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, or to waive any informalities, or to accept the bid or bids deemed best for the West Ada School District.

Each bid exceeding \$50,000 must be accompanied by a bid bond with a surety company licensed to do business in Idaho or a certified/cashier's check drawn on an Idaho Bank in an amount not less than five per cent (5%) of the total bid, made payable to West Ada School District. This surety shall be forfeited by the Bidder in the event of failure to sign the contract or furnish the necessary 100% Performance Bond and the necessary 100% Payment Bond.

Bidders shall be license in the State of Idaho, in accordance with provisions of an act known as "Public Works Contractor's State License Law, Title 54, Chapter 19, Idaho Code Amended." The Term "Public

Works Contractors” includes the general, sub, or specialty contractor. The bidder’s name must agree to the name on the public works license that is referenced in the bid.

The successful Contractors shall carry out their employment practices and payment of wages according to the provisions of an act known as “Public Works Title 44, Chapter 10, Section 44-1001 through 44-1006 inclusive, Idaho Code Amended” and shall comply with the Equal Employment Opportunity Provisions as defined in the code of respective Federal Regulations.
