Bids will be opened and read aloud via teleconference on Monday, June 22 at 10:00 AM MDT. Bids received after the bid opening time will not be considered and no bidder may withdraw his/her bid after the time set for opening or before bid award unless said award is delayed for a period exceeding sixty (60) days.

In following guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the District requires that Contractors, and their subcontractors, are responsible for taking all reasonably practical measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19. In the event of the successful bidder's failure to execute the contract, this bid surety may be forfeited to West Ada School District at the sole discretion of the Board of Trustees.

The Board of Trustees of West Ada School District reserves the right to disregard all non-conforming, non-responsive or conditional bids, to waive any minor informality/irregularity, to reject all bids, or to accept the bid or bids it deems best.
