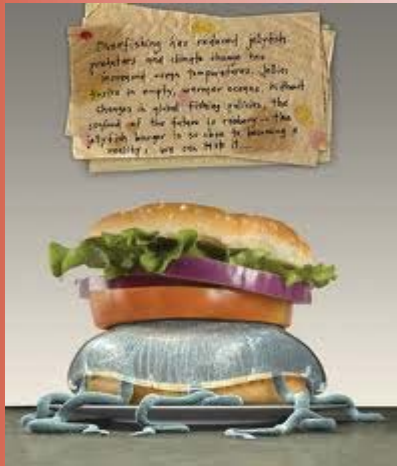

## Food

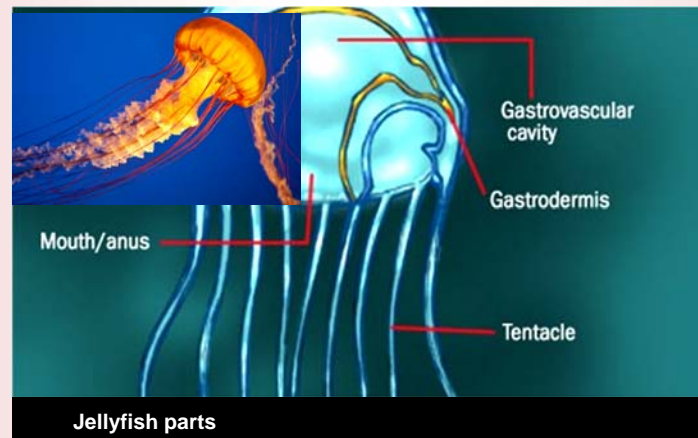
**Jellyfish mainly live off fish eggs but they also eat: small fish, Shrimp, And small plants.**
