Snowy owls breed on the arctic tundra. Snowy owl females lay up to 3 to 11 eggs. Also snowy owls have great eye sight and hearing to catch their prey. An adult snowy owl can eat more than 1600 lemmings a year. It's species name is *Bubo scandiacus*.
