Last fact is they run very fast. The species name is Equua zebra, burchells zebra,

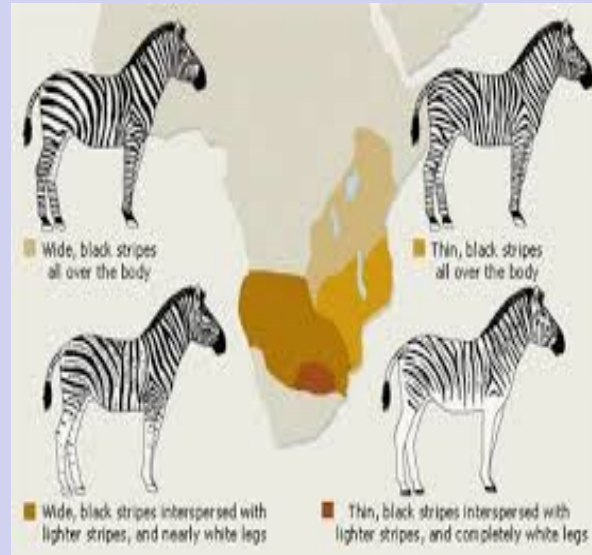


Human Interactions with Zebras
