**Story:** How Animals Communicate


**Comprehension Focus:**

This month in science we are starting our unit called Spinning Sky. This unit helps students develop the idea that the sun, moon and stars change position in the sky in ways that are fun to watch and predict. There are many fun lessons and experiments that we will be doing!

### Math

In math this week we are working on subtraction. Students are learning that we can write number sentences in many ways. Also a big part is in subtraction our number sentences start with the whole amount or the total.

$$9-7=2 \quad 9-2=7$$
